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### PROCEDURE

>Enrollment in College Credit English requires a 3.0 unweighted GPA. If your unweighted GPA falls below 3.0 prior to the first day of school, you will be removed from College Credit English enrollment and placed in an alternate course. You must maintain a 3.0 unweighted GPA and earn a C in English 101 first semester for second semester enrollment in English 102.
