- Enrollment in College Statistics requires a 3.0 unweighted GPA and a minimum score of 22 on the Mathematics portion of the ACT or 250 on the Accuplacer (in Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra and Statistics – QAS). The student must be a senior.

Note: If your unweighted GPA falls below 3.0 or you have not met the ACT/Accuplacer score before the first day of school, you will be removed from College Statistics enrollment and placed in an alternate course.
